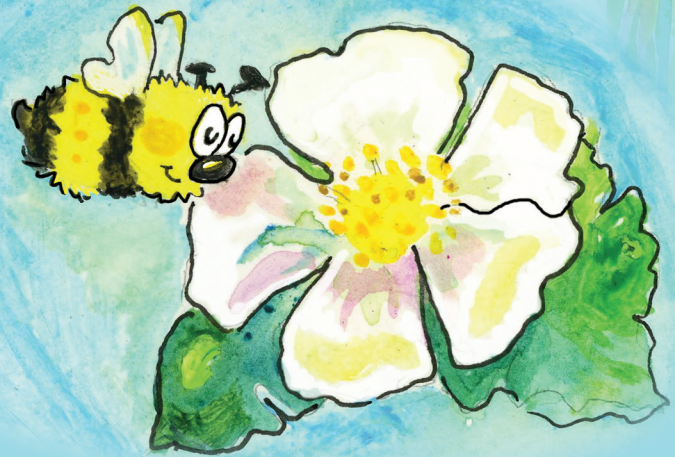



they'll heal Bee there instead.

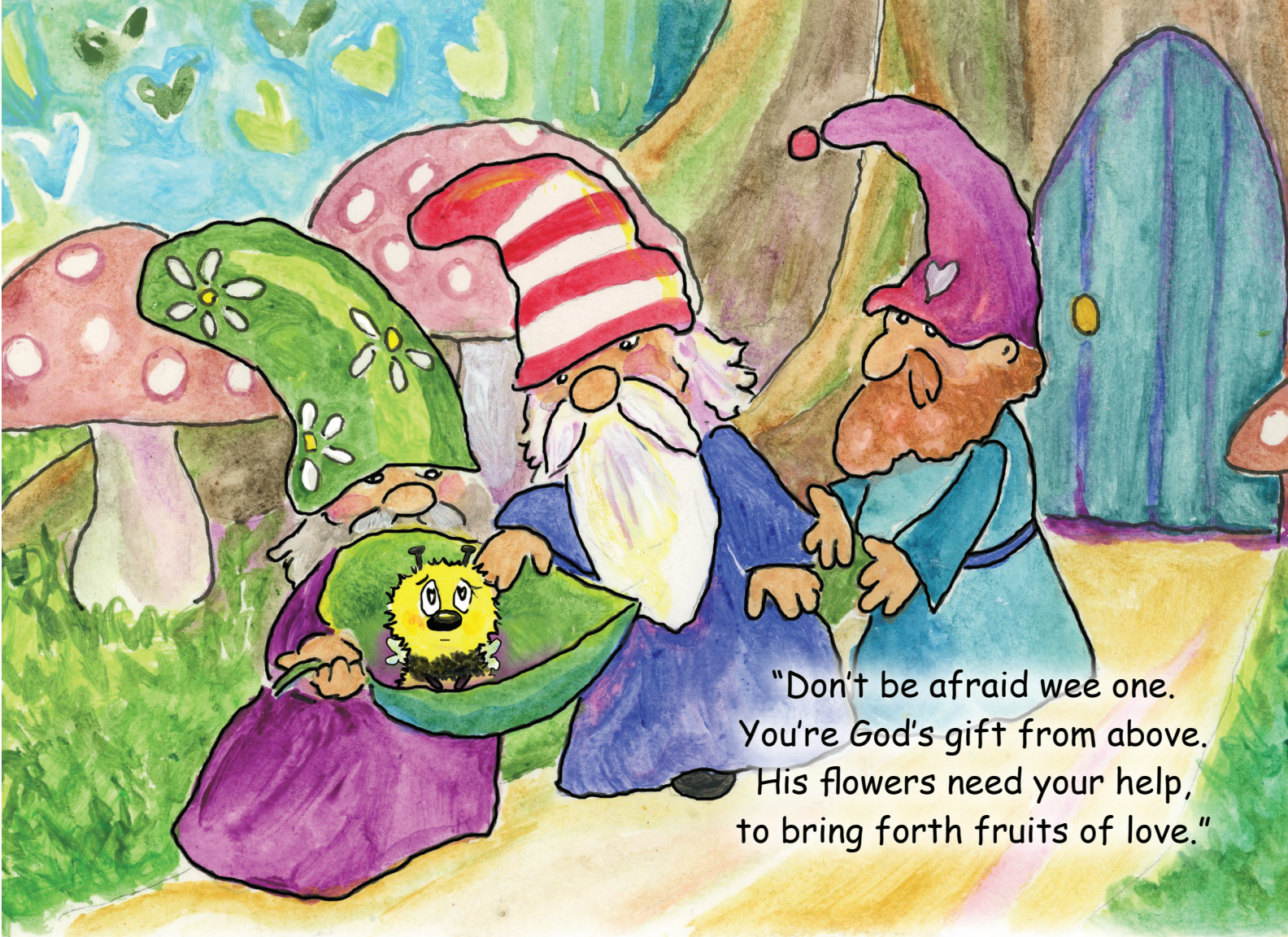




Now on a comfy bed,
